AN ACT TO AMEND NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL STATUTE 116-45(2) DEFINING THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF PEMBROKE STATE COLLEGE.
THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF PEMBROKE STATE COLLEGE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
Section 1. G.S. 116-45(2) as found in Volume 3A of the General Statutes of North
Carolina is hereby amended to read as follows:
"The primary purpose of Pembroke State College shall be to provide undergraduate
instruction in the liberal arts and sciences, to prepare teachers, and to undertake such other
undergraduate, graduate, and professional programs as are deemed necessary to meet the needs
of the State. The educational programs of the institution shall be subject to the approval of the
North Carolina Board of Higher Education, consistent with appropriations made therefor."
Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 27th day of March,
1969.
