SENATE BILL 73

1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 20-7(f) TO PERMIT A PERSON TEMPORARILY RESIDING  
2 OUTSIDE NORTH CAROLINA TO RENEW AN OPERATOR'S LICENSE BY MAIL.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** Subsection (f) of G.S. 20-7, as the same appears in the 1967 Supplement  
7 to the 1965 Replacement Volume 1C of the General Statutes, is amended by deleting the last  
8 paragraph thereof, and by inserting in lieu thereof, the following language:

9 "Any person serving in the armed forces of the United States on active duty and holding a  
10 valid operator's license properly issued under this section and stationed outside the State of  
11 North Carolina may renew his license by making application to the Department by mail. Any  
12 other person, except a nonresident as defined in this article, who holds a valid operator's license  
13 issued under this section and who is temporarily residing outside North Carolina, may also  
14 renew by making application to the Department by mail. For purposes of this Section  
15 'temporarily' shall mean not less than thirty days continuous absence from North Carolina. In  
16 either case, the Department may waive the examination and color photograph ordinarily  
17 required for the renewal of an operator's license, and may impose in lieu thereof such  
18 conditions as it may deem appropriate to each particular application; provided that such license  
19 shall expire thirty days after licensee returns to North Carolina, and such license shall be  
20 designated as temporary."

21 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

22 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.
