8	Section 1. Chapter 160 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by inserting
9	therein a new Section, to be designated G.S. 160-20.3, and to read as follows:
10	"G.S. 160-20.3. Auxiliary police. The governing body of any city or town may by ordinance
11	provide for the organization of an auxiliary police department, made up of volunteer members.
12	Duly appointed and sworn members of any auxiliary police department shall, while undergoing
13	official training and while performing duties on behalf of the city or town pursuant to orders or
14	instructions of the Police Chief of the city or town, be entitled to all powers, privileges, and
15	immunities afforded by law to regularly employed policemen, including benefits under The
16	North Carolina Workmen's Compensation Act."
17	Sec. 2. G.S. 97-2(5), as the same appears in the 1967 Cumulative Supplement to
18	Volume 2D of the General Statutes, is hereby amended as follows:
19	(a) by inserting in the second line of the last paragraph thereof, between the word
20	"squad" and the word "under", the words "or duly appointed and sworn member of an auxiliary
21	police department organized pursuant to G.S. 160-20.3"; and
22	(b) by inserting at the end of the fourth line of the last paragraph thereof,
23	immediately following the word "squad", the words "or member of an auxiliary police
24	department".
25	Sec. 3. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
26	Sec. 4. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.
