4	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6	Section 1. G.S. 95-86(3)b, as the same appears in Volume 2C of the General
7	Statutes, is rewritten to read as follows:
8	"b. Any person employed in domestic service or in or about a private
9	home or in an eleemosynary institution primarily supported by public
10	funds;"
11	Sec. 2. G.S. 95-86(3)d is rewritten to read as follows:
12	"d. Newsboys, shoe shine boys, caddies on golf courses, baby sitters,
13	ushers, doormen, concession attendants and cashiers in theaters;".
14	Sec. 3. G.S. 95-86(3)f is hereby repealed.
15	Sec. 4. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
16	hereby repealed.
17	Sec. 5. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 1970.
18	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 15th day of April,
19	1969.
