| 6 | Section 1. Subsection (c) of G.S. 20-183.2, as the same appears in the 1967 |
| 7 | Supplement to 1965 Replacement Volume 1C of the General Statutes, is amended by adding at |
| 8 | the end thereof the following: "Provided, however, a purchaser of a motor vehicle, who is |
| 9 | licensed as a self-inspector, may conduct the required inspection, after entering into a written |
| 10 | agreement with the dealer to follow such a procedure. A copy of such dealer-purchaser |
| 11 | agreement must be filed with the Department of Motor Vehicles. Provided further, that any new |
| 12 | and unregistered vehicle sold to a nonresident (as defined in G.S. 20-6) shall be exempt from |
| 13 | the requirements of this section if such vehicle is not required to be registered in this State." |
| 14 | Sec. 2. All laws and all clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed. |
| 15 | Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification. |
