CHAPTER 290
SENATE BILL 307

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GREENSBORO CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION
AND THE CITY OF GREENSBORO TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS
WHEREBY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY FURNISH THE CITY
CERTAIN SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY'S RECREATION
PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The Greensboro City Board of Education, hereinafter referred to as the "board", and the City of Greensboro, hereinafter referred to as the "city", are authorized to enter annually into a contract whereby the board may furnish to the city certain services and certain school buses necessary for the performance of such services in connection with the city's recreation programs.

Sec. 2. Each such contract shall contain such terms and conditions and shall be for such compensation as may be agreed upon by the board and the city; provided, however, that the buses to be used for such purpose shall be such buses as shall be owned by the board and as will not be needed by the board for school purposes during the periods when they are used in connection with the city's recreation programs.

Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 22nd day of April, 1969.
