| 6  | Section 1. There is hereby enacted a statute to be designated as G.S. 113-139 and to           |
| 7  | read as follows:   |
| 8  | "G. S. 113-139. Search warrants. (a) Inspectors and protectors are authorized to obtain and    |
| 9  | execute search warrants within the limitations of this section from any official authorized to |
| 10 | issue search warrants in accordance with the procedure in Article 4 of Chapter 15 of the       |
| 11 | General Statutes.  |
| 12 | "(b) Search warrants which inspectors may execute must be for evidence, fruits, or             |
| 13 | instrumentalities of some criminal offense as to which the Department is granted exclusive or  |
| 14 | primary jurisdiction in this subchapter.   |
| 15 | "(c) Search warrants which protectors may execute must be for evidence, fruits, or             |
| 16 | instrumentalities of some criminal offense as to which the Commission is granted exclusive or  |
| 17 | primary jurisdiction in this chapter or elsewhere, including Chapters 75A and 143."            |
| 18 | Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.            |
| 19 | Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect upon ratification.                          |
| 20 | In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 28th day of April,             |
