1	AN ACT TO REWRITE G.S. 148-23, REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF PRISON

4	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6	Section 1. G.S. 148-23 is hereby rewritten to read as follows:
7	"G. S. 148-23. Prison employees not to use intoxicants or profanity. — No one addicted to
8	the use of intoxicating liquors, or narcotic drugs, shall be employed as superintendent, warden,
9	guard, or in any other position connected with the State Department of Correction, where such
10	position requires the incumbent to have any charge or direction of the prisoners; and anyone
11	holding such position, or anyone who may be employed in any other capacity in the State
12	prison system, who shall come under the influence of intoxicating liquors during hours of
13	employment, or reports for duty under the effect of intoxicants, or narcotic drugs, or who shall
14	become intoxicated, or uses narcotic drugs, under circumstances that bring discredit on the
15	State Department of Correction, shall be subject to immediate dismissal from employment by
16	any of the institutions and shall not be eligible for reinstatement to such position or be
17	employed in any other position in any of the institutions. Any superintendent, warden, guard,
18	supervisor, or other person holding any position in the State Department of Correction who
19	curses a prisoner under his charge shall be subject to immediate dismissal from employment
20	and shall not be eligible for reinstatement."
21	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect upon ratification.
