CHAPTER 414  
HOUSE BILL 693

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER 396, PUBLIC-LOCAL LAWS OF 1937,  
RELATING TO THE SALE OF BEER AND WINE IN THE VILLAGE OF  
SWANNANOA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

**Section 1.** Chapter 396, Public-Local Laws of 1937, is hereby repealed.

**Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby  
repealed.

**Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 5th day of  
May, 1969.
