SENATE BILL 10

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF SCHOOL BUSES AS NEEDED FOR
2 INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS AND TO TRANSPORT PUPILS WITH SPECIAL
3 NEEDS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7 **Section 1.** G.S. 115-183 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (4.5) as
8 follows:

9 "(4.5) County or city boards of education, under such rules and regulations as they
10 shall adopt, may permit the use and operation of school buses for the
11 transportation of pupils and instructional personnel as the board deems
12 necessary to serve the instructional programs of the schools. Included in the
13 use permitted by this section is the transportation of children with special
14 needs, such as mentally retarded children and children with physical defects,
15 and children enrolled in programs that require transportation from the school
16 grounds during the school day, such as special vocational or occupational
17 programs. On any such trip, a city or county-owned school bus shall not be
18 taken out of the State.

19 If state funds are inadequate to pay for the transportation approved by the
20 local board of education, local funds may be used for these purposes. County
21 or city boards of education shall determine that funds are available to such
22 boards for the transportation of children to and from the school to which
23 they are assigned for the entire school year before authorizing the use and
24 operation of school buses for other services deemed necessary to serve the
25 instructional program of the schools.

26 **Sec. 2.** G.S. 115-183(5) is hereby amended by striking the first sentence therefrom.

27 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
28 hereby repealed.

29 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from July 1, 1969.

30 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 7th day of March,
31 1969.
