HOUSE BILL 348

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 20 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES BY PLACING
2 THEREIN A NEW DEFINITION OF RESIDENT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** G.S. 20-6 as the same appears in the 1965 Replacement Volume 1C of
7 the General Statutes is hereby amended by inserting therein between the definition of
8 "Cancelled" and the definition of "Revocation", the following definition of "Resident":

9 "Resident - Any individual who resides within this State for other than a temporary or
10 transitory purpose for more than six months shall be presumed to be a resident of this State; but
11 absence from the State for more than six months shall raise no presumption that the individual
12 is not a resident of the State."

13 **Sec. 2.** G.S. 20-38(26) as the same appears in the 1965 Replacement Volume 1C of
14 the General Statutes is hereby amended by rewriting same to read as follows:

15 "Resident - Any individual who resides within this State for other than a temporary or
16 transitory purpose for more than six months shall be presumed to be a resident of this State; but
17 absence from the State for more than six months shall raise no presumption that the individual
18 is not a resident of the State."

19 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

20 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.
