## CHAPTER 608 HOUSE BILL 866

AN ACT TO CHANGE AND CONVERT NORTH CAROLINA COLLEGE OF DURHAM
TO A REGIONAL UNIVERSITY WITH THE NAME AND DESIGNATION OF
"NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY."
The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
Section 1. Article 1A of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes, as the same appears
in the 1967 Cumulative Supplement to Volume 3A of the General Statutes, is hereby amended
to add a new Section to read as follows:
"Effective July 1, 1969:
"(1) North Carolina College at Durham is redesignated 'North Carolina Central
University', and is made subject to the provisions of Section 116-44.10.
"(2) In all other statutes and titles or captions thereof, the words 'North Carolina
College at Durham' and the words 'North Carolina College of Durham' are
amended to read 'North Carolina Central University'."
<b>Sec. 2.</b> Subsection (3) of Section 116-45 is repealed effective July 1, 1969.
Sec. 3. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
Sec. 4. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 27th day of May,
1969.
