1	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR REVIEW AND TERMINATION OF PROBATION AFTER A
2	PERIOD OF PROBATION.

4	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6	Section 1. Chapter 15 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new
7	section, immediately after G.S. 15-205 to be designated as G.S. 15-205.1, to read as follows:
8	"G.S. 15-205.1. Mandatory review of probation. It shall be the duty of the probation officer
9	in all cases referred to him to bring the probationer before the appropriate court having
10	jurisdiction for review by the judge to determine whether the probationer should be released
11	from probation after the probationer has actually been on probation for one year, if the period
12	of probation was three years or less, or he has been on probation for three years if the period of
13	probation was for more than three years. The court shall review the probationer's case file and
14	determine whether he should be released from probation. This section shall not restrict the
15	court's power to continue, extend, suspend or terminate the period of probation at any time as
16	provided in G.S. 15-200."
17	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
18	Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

20	1969.
