SENATE BILL 128

1 AN ACT AMENDING G.S. 127-14 AND G.S. 127-23.1 RELATING TO THE ASSISTANT
2 TO THE ADJUTANT GENERAL AND TO COMMISSIONS BY BREVET.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
5

6 **Section 1.** G.S. 127-14, as the same appears in the 1967 Cumulative Supplement to
7 Volume 3B, is amended by inserting after the word "shall" and before the word "receive" in
8 line 22 thereof the words "be a full-time employee of the Adjutant General's department and
9 shall".

10 **Sec. 2.** G.S. 127-23.1 is amended by rewriting all of the second sentence of the first
11 paragraph thereof as follows:

12 "The commissions by brevet shall be in grade as follows: A commissioned officer shall be
13 commissioned by brevet in a grade one grade higher than the highest grade satisfactorily held
14 by him while serving on active duty during any war, including service on active duty in the
15 Korean conflict or in the Vietnamese conflict, or while serving actively as a federally
16 recognized officer of the North Carolina National Guard; a warrant officer shall be
17 commissioned by brevet in the grade of captain or in a grade one grade higher than the highest
18 commissioned grade satisfactorily held by him while serving on active duty during any war,
19 including service on active duty in the Korean conflict or in the Vietnamese conflict, or while
20 serving actively as a federally recognized member of the North Carolina National Guard; an
21 enlisted man shall be commissioned by brevet in the grade of first lieutenant or in a grade one
22 grade higher than the highest commissioned grade satisfactorily held by him while serving on
23 active duty during any war, including service on active duty in the Korean conflict or in the
24 Vietnamese conflict, or while serving actively as a federally recognized member of the North
25 Carolina National Guard.

26 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

27 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

29 1969.
