6		<b>n 1.</b> There is hereby created an advisory council to be known as the	
7	•	il on Alcoholism to the North Carolina Board of Mental Health." The council	
8	shall be composed	d of the following members:	
9	(1)	The respective chairmen of the House and Senate Committees on Mental	
10		Health.	
11	(2)	A Judge of the Superior Court to be appointed by the Chief Justice of	
12		Supreme Court of the State of North Carolina to serve for a term of three (3)	
13		years.	
14	(3)	A member of the North Carolina State Bar to be appointed by the President	
15		of the North Carolina State Bar Association to serve for a term of three (3)	
16		years.	
17	(4)	Four (4) members to be appointed by the Executive Committee of the	
18		Alcoholism Programs of North Carolina. The term of appointment shall be	
19		for three (3) years except that two (2) of the first four (4) members appointed	
20		shall serve for only two (2) years.	
21	(5)	Four (4) members to be appointed by the North Carolina Board of Mental	
22		Health. The term of appointment shall be for three (3) years except that two	
23		(2) of the first four (4) members appointed shall serve for only two (2) years.	
24	(6)	The council shall choose its own chairman.	
25	Sec. 2	. The advisory council shall study, evaluate and make recommendations to	
26	the State Board of	Mental Health in areas as:	
27	(a)	State and community treatment programs in alcoholism.	
28	(b)	Ways and means of promoting public understanding of alcoholism and

32	(d)	Educational programs on alcoholism and alcohol problems in public schools

36	(f)	Training programs in area of alcoholism.	
37	(g)	The need for new State laws and programs in the field of alcohol problems.

40	Sec. 3	. The advisory council shall make an annual report to the State Board of
