5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7 Section 1. Unless otherwise agreed, where unsolicited goods are delivered by mail or common carrier to a person, he has a right to refuse to accept delivery of the goods and is not 8 bound to return such goods to the sender. If such unsolicited goods are addressed to and 9 10 intended for the recipient, they shall be deemed a gift to the recipient, who may use them or dispose of them in any manner without any obligation to the sender. 11 12

- Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1969. 13
