3	COMMISSION OR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM THE UTILITIES

6	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

8	Section 1. Chapter 62 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new
9	section at the end thereof to read as follows:
10	"G.S. 62-326. Furnishing False Information to the Commission; Withholding Information
11	from the Commission. (a) Every person, firm or corporation operating under the jurisdiction
12	of the Utilities Commission or who is required by law to file reports with the Commission who
13	shall knowingly or wilfully file or give false information to the Utilities Commission in any
14	report, reply, response, or other statement or document furnished to the Commission shall be
15	guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined or imprisoned in the discretion of the court."
16	"(b) Every person, firm, or corporation operating under the jurisdiction of the Utilities
17	Commission or who is required by law to file reports with the Commission who shall wilfully
18	withhold clearly specified and reasonably obtainable information from the Commission in any
19	report, response, reply or statement filed with the Commission in the performance of the duties
20	of the Commission or who shall fail or refuse to file any report, response, reply or statement
21	required by the Commission in the performance of the duties of the Commission shall be guilty
22	of a misdemeanor and shall be fined or imprisoned in the discretion of the court."
23	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
24	hereby repealed.
25	Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after September 15, 1969.
