1 AN ACT TO VALIDATE THE ACTS OF CERTAIN NOTARIES WHERE THE NOTARY
2 SEAL INCORRECTLY CONTAINED THE NAME OF ANOTHER STATE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** The notarial acts of any person heretofore duly commissioned as a
7 notary public in this State, who used in performing such acts a seal correctly containing the
8 name of the notary and the proper county but mistakenly containing the abbreviation for the
9 State of Georgia instead of North Carolina, are hereby validated and given the same legal effect
10 as if such misprint or incorrect designation of the State had not appeared on the seal or seal
11 imprint so used.

12 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

13 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.
