6	Section 1. G.S. 134-22 is hereby amended by striking out from the second line
7	thereof the words "the State Home and Industrial School for Girls" and substituting the words
8	"Samarkand Manor".
9	Sec. 2 G.S. 134-33(1) is hereby amended by striking out the words "the State Home
10	and Industrial School for Girls and Women" and substituting in lieu thereof the words
11	"Samarkand Manor".
12	Sec. 3. G.S. 134-34 is hereby amended by striking out from the third line thereof
13	the words "State Home and Industrial School for Girls" and substituting in lieu thereof the
14	words "Samarkand Manor".
15	Sec. 4. Wherever else in the General Statutes the words "State Home and Industrial
16	School for Girls" may appear, the same shall be stricken out and the words "Samarkand Manor"
17	inserted in lieu thereof.
18	Sec. 5. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
19	Sec. 6. This Act shall become effective upon ratification.
20	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 16th day of June,
21	1969.
