HOUSE BILL 1103

1 AN ACT AMENDING G.S. 106-189, RELATING TO THE LABELING REQUIREMENTS
2 FOR THE SALE OF FARM PRODUCTS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT UNGRADED
3 PEACHES NEED NOT BE SO LABELED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
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7 **Section 1.** G.S. 106-189 is amended by inserting a sentence after the sentence
8 ending in line 9 thereof as follows: "This proviso shall not apply to peaches".

9 **Sec. 2.** It is the intent and purpose of this Act to exempt peaches from the
10 requirements of Article 17 of Chapter 106 that ungraded peaches, when sold or offered for sale,
11 shall be marked "ungraded", "field run", "not graded", "grade not determined" or
12 "unclassified", or words of similar import.

13 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

14 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall be in full force and effect upon ratification.
