1 AN ACT RELATING TO THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STATE TRAINING SCHOOLS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

5 **Section 1.** The names of the "Stonewall Jackson Manual Training and Industrial
6 School" and "Morrison Training School" and "Leonard Training School" are here- by changed
7 to "Stonewall Jackson School" and "Cameron Morrison School" and "Samuel Leonard School",
8 respectively, and wherever the same appear in Chapter 134 of the General Statutes and any
9 other laws of this State, said Chapter 134 and all other such laws are hereby amended to effect
10 the changes above set forth.

11 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

12 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective July 1, 1969.
