3	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

5	Section 1. The names of the "Stonewall Jackson Manual Training and Industrial
6	School" and "Morrison Training School" and "Leonard Training School" are here- by changed
7	to "Stonewall Jackson School" and "Cameron Morrison School" and "Samuel Leonard School",
8	respectively, and wherever the same appear in Chapter 134 of the General Statutes and any
9	other laws of this State, said Chapter 134 and all other such laws are hereby amended to effect
10	the changes above set forth.
11	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
12	Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1969.
13	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 17th day of June,
14	1969.
