SENATE BILL 784

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE MANNER IN WHICH COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL
2 BOARDS OF ALCOHOLIC CONTROL MAY MAKE EXPENDITURES FOR
3 EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND REHABILITATION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7 **Section 1.** Subsection (15) of G.S. 18-45 is hereby amended by deleting the second
8 sentence thereof which reads: "In addition, any county or municipal board is authorized, in its
9 discretion, to expend for education and research as to the effects of the use of alcoholic
10 beverages and for the rehabilitation of alcoholics not more than five percent (5%) of its total
11 profits, to be determined by quarterly audits." and by adding a new paragraph at the end of the
12 subsection to read as follows:

13 "In addition, any county or municipal board is authorized, in its discretion, to expend not
14 more than five percent (5%) of its total profits, to be determined by quarterly audits, for
15 education and research as to the causes and effects of alcoholism or the excessive use of
16 alcoholic beverages and for the rehabilitation of alcoholics. Expenditures for the purposes
17 specified in this paragraph may be made, in the discretion of the board, either for programs
18 carried on by the board or as appropriations to non-profit corporations or agencies sponsoring
19 or engaging in such education, research or rehabilitation."

20 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

21 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall take effect upon its ratification.
