SENATE BILL 754

1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 14-110 RELATING TO OBTAINING ENTERTAINMENT AT
2 HOTELS AND BOARDINGHOUSES WITHOUT PAYING THEREFOR SO AS TO
3 MAKE CERTAIN CONDUCT PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THEREOF.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7 **Section 1.** G.S. 14-110 is amended by rewriting this Section in its entirety to read
8 as follows:

9 **"G.S. 14-110. Defrauding Inn Keeper.** No person shall, with intent to defraud, obtain food,
10 lodging, or other accommodations at a hotel, inn, boardinghouse or eating house. Whoever
11 violates this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall upon conviction be fined or
12 imprisoned at the discretion of the court. Obtaining such lodging, food, or other
13 accommodation by false pretense, or by false or fictitious show of pretense of baggage or other
14 property, or absconding without paying or offering to pay therefor, or surreptitiously removing
15 or attempting to remove such baggage, shall be prima facie evidence of such fraudulent intent,
16 but this Section shall not apply where there has been an agreement in writing for delay in such
17 payment."

18 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

19 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.
