AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 127 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES SO AS TO GRANT

1969.

CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL GUARD OR STATE
DEFENSE MILITIA IMMUNITY FROM CRIMINAL OR CIVIL LIABILITY FOR
ACTS DONE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES DURING TIME OF
PUBLIC DISASTER OR CRISIS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
·
Section 1. Chapter 127 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by inserting a
new section immediately following G.S. 127-106.1 to be designated as G.S. 127-106.2 and to
read as follows:
"G.S. 127-106.2. Immunity of guardsmen from civil and criminal liability. (a) A member
of the North Carolina National Guard or State defense militia in active State service, while
acting in aid of civil authorities and in the line of duty shall have the immunities of a law
enforcement officer.
"(b) Whenever members of the North Carolina National Guard or State defense militia
are called into active State service to execute the laws, engage in disaster relief, suppress or
prevent actual or threatened riot or insurrection, repel invasion. apprehend or disperse any
snipers, rioters, mob or unlawful assembly, they shall have the immunities of a law
enforcement officer.
Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
hereby repealed.
Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
