1	AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 18 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES SO AS TO CREATE
2	A PRESUMPTION OF KNOWLEDGE OF THE AGE OF A PURCHASER OF MALT
3	BEVERAGES.

5	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7	Section 1. Chapter 18 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new
8	section to be codified as G.S. 18-78.2 and to read as follows:
9	G.S. 18-78.2. Presumption of knowledge of age of purchaser. Whenever a sale of beverages
10	as defined in Sec. 18-64 is made to a person under the age of eighteen (18) years, it shall be
11	prima facie evidence that the person making the sale had knowledge that the purchaser was
12	under the age of eighteen (18) years. Such prima facie evidence may be rebutted by showing
13	that the purchaser produced for inspection a drivers license, selective service card, school
14	identification card, or military identification card showing the age of the purchaser to be
15	eighteen (18) years or more and the description of the physical appearance of the person on the
16	identification card reasonably describes the purchaser. In the absence of such identification, the
17	prima facie evidence of knowledge of age may be rebutted by the vendor by other evidence
18	which reasonably indicated at the time of sale that the purchaser was eighteen (18) years of age
19	or more.
20	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
21	Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.
