CHAPTER 1289
HOUSE BILL 2144

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE FORM OF GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF
PEMBROKE TO THE COUNCIL-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The form of municipal government in the Town of Pembroke is hereby changed to the Council-Manager form of government. Wherever the words "Board of Town Commissioners" or the word "Commissioner" appear in the Town Charter, they shall be changed to read "Town Council" or "Councilman" to conform with the change of the form of government.

Sec. 2. The Town Council shall proceed to appoint a Town Manager under the provisions of Article 7, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina. Any provisions of the Town Charter inconsistent with the Council-Manager form of government, are hereby modified to the extent necessary to conform with the Council-Manager form established by this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall be effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 11th day of April, 1974.
