CHAPTER 227
HOUSE BILL 707

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER 81 OF THE PRIVATE LAWS OF 1883 AND TO
PROVIDE FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF ENOCHSVILLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 81 of the Session Laws of 1883 is hereby repealed and the corporate limits of the Town of Enochville, as provided for in Chapter 185 of the Laws of 1876-77, reestablished.

Sec. 2. Beginning in November of 1973, municipal elections in the Town of Enochville shall be held pursuant to the provisions of Articles 23 and 24 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes. The elections shall be held on a nonpartisan basis and determined by a simple plurality. There shall be no primary elections.

Sec. 3. Municipal elections in the Town of Enochville shall be conducted by and under the supervision of the Rowan County Board of Elections.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 17th day of April, 1973.
