SENATE BILL 312

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 623 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1971,  
AFFECTING THE TOWN OF BENSON.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**Section 1.** Section 14.1(a) of Article XIV of Section 1 of Chapter 623 of the Session Laws of 1971 is amended by striking the following portion of the last sentence thereof, "provided, further, that such petition must be presented as herein provided to such Board of Commissioners on or before June 30, 1973;" and by deleting the semicolon after the words "Town Hall" and inserting in lieu thereof a period.

**Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

**Sec. 3.** This act shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 27th day of April, 1973.
