CHAPTER 810  
SENATE BILL 855

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAMES OF NORTH CAROLINA SANATORIUM FOR THE  
TREATMENT OF TUBERCULOSIS TO MCCAIN HOSPITAL AND GRAVELY  
SANATORIUM AT CHAPEL HILL TO GRAVELY HOSPITAL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**Section 1.** The title to Article 7, Chapter 131, as the same appears in Volume 3B of the General Statutes, is hereby rewritten to read: "McCain Hospital."

**Sec. 2.** The words "North Carolina Sanatorium for the treatment of tuberculosis" wherever the same appear in Articles 7, 8, 9, and 11, Chapter 131, Volume 3B of the General Statutes, are hereby deleted and the following substituted in lieu thereof: "McCain Hospital".

**Sec. 3.** Chapter 131 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to be designated "Gravelly Hospital" and a new section thereunder to read:

"§ 131-82.1. **Gravelly Hospital.** — The State institution for treatment of tuberculosis at Chapel Hill existing under the name of 'Gravelly Sanatorium' shall hereafter exist and be known as 'Gravelly Hospital'."

**Sec. 4.** This act shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 24th day of May, 1973.
