CHAPTER 1237
SENATE BILL 995

AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 138-6(a)(3) WHICH PROVIDES SUBSISTENCE AND TRAVEL
ALLOWANCE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 138-6(a)(3) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(3) In lieu of actual expenses incurred for subsistence, payment of twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00) per day when traveling in-state or thirty-nine dollars (\$39.00) per day when traveling out-of-state. When travel involves less than a full day (24-hour period), a reasonable prorated amount shall be paid in accordance with regulations and criteria which shall be promulgated and published by the Director of the Budget. This shall not apply to those employees who are employed by the North Carolina State Burial Association Commission."

Sec. 2. G.S. 138-6(a)(4) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(4) For convention registration fees not to exceed thirty dollars (\$30.00) per convention."

Sec. 3. The heads of departments shall administer the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2 above in a manner to assure that these provisions are funded from within existing authorized budgets.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1978.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 16th day of June, 1978.
