CHAPTER 56  
HOUSE BILL 158

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 146 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1975  
REGARDING THE AUTHORITY OF MUNICIPALITIES AND POLITICAL  
SUBDIVISIONS OF MUNICIPALITIES TO USE THE PROCEDURE  
PROVIDED IN ARTICLE 9 OF CHAPTER 136 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES  
AS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY G.S. 136-66.3(c), AND EXTENDING  
THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF STATESVILLE TO AREAS WITHOUT  
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF STATESVILLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**Section 1.** Section 2 of Chapter 146 of the Session Laws of 1975 is rewritten to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. This act shall apply only to the City of Statesville and land located within the corporate limits of Statesville or within its planning area as defined in G.S. 160A-360."

**Sec. 2.** This act shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 7th day of March, 1977.
