CHAPTER 961  
HOUSE BILL 565

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA ALCOHOLISM  
RESEARCH AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH.

Whereas, there is a recognized need for scientific research into the causes and possible prevention of the addictive disease called alcoholism; and

Whereas, this research is primarily conducted in the universities associated with the four medical schools in North Carolina; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated to the North Carolina Alcoholism Research Authority from the General Fund, in addition to all other appropriations, the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for fiscal year 1977-78, and the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for fiscal year 1978-79, the said appropriations to be expended for scientific research into the causes and prevention of alcoholism.

**Sec. 2.** This act shall become effective July 1, 1977.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 1st day of July, 1977.
