CHAPTER 969  
HOUSE BILL 633

AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 7A-69 TO AUTHORIZE INVESTIGATORIAL ASSISTANTS IN  
CERTAIN JUDICIAL DISTRICTS TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**Section 1.** G.S. 7A-69, as the same is set out in the 1975 Cumulative Supplement to Volume 1B of the General Statutes, is amended by rewriting the first sentence to read as follows:

"The district attorney in the third, fourth, seventh, tenth, eleventh, twelfth, fourteenth, fifteenth-A, sixteenth, eighteenth, twentieth, twenty-first, twenty-fifth, twenty-sixth, twenty-seventh, twenty-eighth, twenty-ninth and thirtieth judicial districts is entitled to one investigatorial assistant to be appointed by the district attorney and to serve at his pleasure."

**Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred thirty-four thousand six hundred and ninety-four dollars (\$134,695) for each fiscal year of the 1977-1979 biennium for an additional investigatorial assistant in the following judicial districts: four, seven, eleven, fifteen-A, sixteen, twenty-five, twenty-nine, and thirty.

**Sec. 3.** This act shall become effective July 1, 1977.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 1st day of July, 1977.
