CHAPTER 1296
HOUSE BILL 1651

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COMMUNITY SERVICE RESTITUTION
PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for fiscal year 1982-83 for the deferred prosecution, community service restitution and volunteer program for youthful and adult offenders authorized by G.S. 143B-475(d). No grant recipient may receive more in fiscal year 1982-83 than it received in fiscal year 1981-82 if it received more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in fiscal year 1981-82. After the program has been in operation for three years, the total amount distributed to all grant recipients in a county may not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1982.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 23rd day of June, 1982.
