CHAPTER 1330
SENATE BILL 851

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE
LAKELAND ARTS CENTER.

Whereas, the Lakeland Arts Center has for five years provided counseling, recreational facilities, and exposure to the arts to Halifax County and the surrounding area; and

Whereas, over 100,000 people have attended performances of the arts at the center; and

Whereas, teachers from the center also teach in the public schools, thereby extending the center's contributions to the State; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Lakeland Arts Center in Littleton for fiscal year 1982-83 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for capital improvements. These funds shall not become part of the continuation budget. Any unexpended funds at the end of the 1982-83 fiscal year shall not revert to the General Fund.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1982.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 23rd day of June, 1982.
