CHAPTER 198
HOUSE BILL 539

AN ACT TO REPEAL A LAW AUTHORIZING A REFERENDUM ON THE
MERGER OF THE TOWNS OF WAYNESVILLE AND HAZELWOOD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 882, Session Laws of 1959, is repealed.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
