CHAPTER 204
SENATE BILL 231

AN ACT TO ALLOW HERTFORD COUNTY TO ESTABLISH PRECINCTS
WITHOUT REGARD TO TOWNSHIP BOUNDARIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 163-128, a county board of elections may divide a county into precincts without regard to township boundaries.

Sec. 2. This act applies to Hertford County only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 13th day of April, 1981.
