CHAPTER 554
HOUSE BILL 945

AN ACT TO CLARIFY WHAT BIRTH CERTIFICATE INFORMATION SHALL BE
RETURNED TO THE REGISTER OF DEEDS IN THE COUNTY OF BIRTH.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130-63(a)(5) is amended by inserting a new sentence between the first and second sentences of that subdivision to read:

"The copy of each certificate of birth so transmitted shall include the color or race of the father and mother if that information is contained on the State copy of the certificate of live birth."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1981.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 12th day of June, 1981.
