CHAPTER 994
HOUSE BILL 1400

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE TO GRANT UTILITY EASEMENTS ACROSS A PORTION OF JOCKEYS RIDGE STATE PARK LYING WITHIN THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 25B of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be designated as G.S. 143-260.10.1 to read as follows:

"§143-260.10.1. Utility easements; Jockeys Ridge State Park. — Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 143-260.10, the State of North Carolina is hereby authorized to grant utility easements to public utility companies across Jockeys Ridge State Park lying within the State Nature and Historic Preserve."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 9th day of October, 1981.
