CHAPTER 226  
HOUSE BILL 506

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF SHELBY TO ESTABLISH, OPERATE  
AND MAINTAIN A PUBLIC MARKET.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. A city is authorized to establish, own, operate, equip, and maintain a public market, and acquire such land as may be necessary for the establishment of a public market; and to appropriate and expend nonproperty tax funds for such purpose. In lieu of the city operating such a market, the city is further authorized to contract with any individual, corporation, nonprofit corporation, governmental body, or any other group for the purpose of operating a public market.

Sec. 2. This act shall apply to the City of Shelby only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 27th day of April, 1983.
