CHAPTER 632
HOUSE BILL 305

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS PERTAINING TO THE EXECUTIVE MANSION
FINE ARTS COMMITTEE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143B-79(5) is amended by deleting the words "Art Commission or the Historical Commission" and substituting "Committee".

Sec. 2. Part 10 of Article 2 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 143B-80.1. Regular and special meetings. – The Executive Mansion Fine Arts Committee shall meet at least twice per year and may hold special meetings at any time and place within the State at the call of the chairman or upon the written request of at least five members.

Whenever a member shall fail, except for ill health or other valid reason, to be present for two successive regular meetings of the Board, his place as a member shall be deemed vacant."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 28th day of June, 1983.
