CHAPTER 651
HOUSE BILL 1199

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE POSITION OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
SERVING ON OTHER BOARDS WHOSE MEMBERS ARE APPOINTED BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 128 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 128-1.2. Ex officio service by county commissioners. – Except when the resolution of appointment provides otherwise, whenever a board of county commissioners appoints one of its own members to another board or commission, the county commissioner so appointed is considered to be serving on the other board or commission as a part of the duties of his office of county commissioner and shall not be considered to be serving in a separate office."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June, 1983.
