CHAPTER 680
SENATE BILL 602

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 147 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES TO ALLOW FOR THE PAYROLL DEDUCTION BY A DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION EMPLOYEE REQUIRED BY FEDERAL AND STATE LAW TO WEAR DAY-GLO ORANGE SHIRTS OR VESTS OF THE COST OF UNIFORM RENTAL AND INSURANCE PREMIUMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The first sentence of G.S. 147-62 is amended by deleting the phrase "and life insurance companies" and substituting the phrase "uniform rental firms to allow employees of the Department of Transportation to rent day-glo orange shirts or vests as required by federal and State law, and medical, hospital, disability and life insurance companies".

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 5th day of July, 1983.
