HOUSE BILL 1226

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE TIME WHEN MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES ARE  
INTRODUCED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 160A-75, as it appears in the 1980 Interim Supplement, is amended by adding the following language:

"For purposes of this section, an ordinance shall be deemed to have been introduced on the date the subject matter is first voted on by the Council."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 6th day of July, 1983.
