CHAPTER 729
SENATE BILL 628

AN ACT TO GIVE THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS A LONGER PERIOD OF
TIME TO DETERMINE NOMINEES FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 163-213.4 is amended by rewriting the first sentence to read:
"The State Board of Elections shall convene in Raleigh on the seventy-fifth (75th) day
preceding the presidential preference primary election."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 12th day of
July, 1983.
