CHAPTER 883
HOUSE BILL 524

AN ACT TO REPEAL ALL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES ADOPTED UNDER THE
A.P.A. ABSENT APPROVAL BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO
REPEAL G.S. 143B-153.1.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. All rules adopted under the provisions of Article 2 of Chapter 150A of the General Statutes which are in effect on January 1, 1985, are repealed effective July 1, 1985, unless approved by the 1985 Session of the General Assembly. The approval of rules by the General Assembly shall not be deemed to enact the approved rules or to prohibit their subsequent amendment, repeal, or recodification by the agency.

Sec. 2. G.S. 143B-153.1 is repealed.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
