CHAPTER 92
HOUSE BILL 308

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE
RELATING TO THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 9.22 of the Charter of the City of Charlotte being Chapter 713, Session Laws of 1965 as amended by Chapter 216, Session Laws of 1967, is amended by the addition of a new paragraph at the end to read:

"The City may convey interests in real property owned by it by private negotiation or sale, with respect to parcels of property having a fair market value of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) or less, and Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes shall not apply to such dispositions. The City Manager is authorized and empowered to approve such dispositions."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 24th day of March, 1983.
