CHAPTER 938
HOUSE BILL 1520

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE STATUTORY BAN ON THE SALE OF SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS, INTOXICATING DRINKS, ALE, BEER, LAGER, PORTER, CIDER OR BITTERS IN THE TOWN OF SILER CITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 8 of Chapter 88, Private Laws of 1887, is repealed.

Sec. 2. Section 9 of Chapter 208, Private Laws of 1899, is repealed.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 21st day of June, 1984.
