CHAPTER 114  
SENATE BILL 225

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING KINDERGARTEN HEALTH  
ASSESSMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**Section 1.** G.S.130A-440(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) The health assessment shall be conducted by a physician licensed to practice medicine, a physician's assistant as defined in G.S.90-18.1(a), a certified nurse practitioner, or a public health nurse meeting the North Carolina Division of Health Services' Standards for Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment Screening."

**Sec. 2.** Section 2 of Chapter 1017, 1985 Session Laws, Regular Session 1986, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1987-January 1, 1988. However, upon ratification of this act, the Commission for Health Services shall adopt rules pursuant to the authority granted under G.S.130A-443. These rules may not become effective until January 1, 1988."

**Sec. 3.** This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 1st day of May, 1987.
